## 4 WEEK INTENSIVE WORKSHOP DRAWING | PAINTING

In this course, students will learn the fundamentals of Drawing and Painting in a method very similar to that experienced by our full-time students. The method of practice is based on centuries of studio practice and based on how old masters studied art principles. The faculty will guide the students to work by themselves and progress step-by-step.

The study is divided into two types. Studio sessions and Model Sessions. It begins with teaching drawing principles, particularly from life and old masters. The projects could be Master Copies, Portraits, Casts and Figures.

The Four-week Intensive Course is designed to further develop the student's drawing accuracy and understanding value relationships. All exercises working from life will continue to challenge the student to select information directly from nature and translate it with greater accuracy in both charcoal and paint;

- Yellow Ochre or Gold Ochre or Mars Yellow Light
- Cadmium Red Light or Cadmium Vermillion
- Alizarin Crimson or Rose Madder
- Cobalt Blue Deep
- Raw Umber
- Ivory Black

- Bristle Filbert Brushes (at least 6 different sizes)
  - Brusto Artists Bristle white Filbert (Series 1008)
- Bristle Round Brushes (at least 4 different sizes)
