

It is vital to have a concise list of the essential materials you need for your session and organize it. The materials must also be easy to set up and clean up.

O1 PAINTING MATERIALS

Sketchbook and graphite pencil or charcoal (just your set for sketch) Canvas will be Provided.

OIL PAINT

Your set is at least 15 colours. You can use your regular set; it doesn't matter in general.

- Titanium White (Important)
- · Lemon Yellow
- · Cadmium Yellow
- Ochre Light
- Raw Sienna
- · Cadmium Orange
- Cadmium Red
- Burnt Sienna or Burnt Umber
- Raw Umber
- Mars Orange Transparent / Transparent Red Oxide
- Van Dyck Brown
- · Viridian Green
- Cobalt Blue
- Cerulean Blue
- Ultramarine Blue
- · Ivory Black or Mars Black

BRUSHES

Large and small, bristles and synthetics, fan bristles and synthetics. Can get your regular set.









MEDIUM (SOLVENT & OIL)

- Odorless Mineral Spirit
- · Refined Linseed Oil





Note: Do not Bring Turpentine as it is harmful to health and not allowed in the academy.

OTHERS

- Palette Knife Tear Drop Shape. Should be flexible.
- · Kitchen Roll or Rag
- Stainless Steel Brush Cleaner
- Medium Cups with lid



O2 DRAWING MATERIALS

Paper will be provided. I want everyone to be creative in their work and choose one of three possibilities:

- · Graphite with wet sauce drawing
- · Graphite drawing with toning
- · Charcoal drawing

The aspect ratio of the sides of your drawing can be different: square or rectangular. It will depend on your composition.

- Sketchbook
- Graphite pencils B-8B (for graphite drawing) or charcoal pencils (not wooden charcoal)
- Soft brushes (for wet sauce technique)
- Erasers Brand: Milan, Koh-I-Noor (Hard Eraser & Kneaded) or your favourite
- Pencil sharpener / Box Cutter & Sandpaper Block

If someone wants to experiment and choose a different technique or material, I'll be happy; watercolours is the only thing I don't work with.
